Performances

Some special performances by HYP include:

- **Fall Concert**—Start the season off with a fall concert and masquerade, to be held in October.
- **Night of Dance**—Each November, HYP presents a Night of Dance, when couples can dance everything from ballroom waltzes to twists. Patrons also enjoy refreshments at their candlelit tables.
- **Holiday Concert**—Held in December to get you in the holiday spirit, this concert includes the over 100-piece combined orchestras of the three MCCSC middle schools.
- **String Spectacular Concert**—This January concert extravaganza features all of the string students of the MCCSC—grades 5 through 12. More than 400 young musicians perform in this gala presentation!
